What are the different Child Care Services?

Long Day Care Centres	Generally cater for children from 6 weeks to 5 years and open for 10 hours per day (but this may vary).
Pre-School/Kindergartens	Generally for children aged 3 to 5 years and open between 9am and 3pm.
Family Day Care	Family Day Care Educators operate from their homes and are supported by a central coordination unit, flexible hours.
Occasional Child Care	Service for children aged from 0 to 5 years whose parents need temporary or occasional care for them.
Outside School Hours Care	Before and After School Care and Vacation Care for children who have started school, up to 12 years of age.
Home Based Child Care	Child carers operating independently from their homes.

Note: The terms 'pre-school' and 'kindergarten' are sometimes used in long day care service titles.

Who provides Child Care?

Child Care may be provided either by a community based not-for-profit organisation (such as a local Council) or by a private provider (either a sole operator or a company).

In Warringah, no pre-school services operate within the State Government school system, although some pre-school services are operated by independent schools.

How can I tell if the service is good quality?

REGULATED CHILD CARE

All child care in NSW must be licensed under the NSW Children's Service Regulation 2004. The Regulation sets out minimum standards for physical environments and facilities at the premises and for the operation of services, including policies and procedures, staffing ratios, child protection and requirements for teaching staff. Licenses are required to be publicly displayed at services.

All licensed services are now required to develop programs for children in accordance with the National Early Years Learning Framework.

CERTIFIED PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

As defined under the Federal Government's new National Quality Standard, certified preschool programs are "play based learning programs planned and delivered by an early childhood qualified teacher for a minimum of 10 hours/week for 40 weeks per year" delivered by services in the year before full-time schooling (4 years).

ACCREDITED CHILD CARE

Services whose families are eligible for fee assistance through the Child Care Benefit and the Child Care Rebate schemes must undergo service accreditation. Accreditation is a continuous improvement process, leading to independent assessment of service quality by the National Childcare Accreditation Council (NCAC). Accreditation results are required to be publicly displayed at services.

At present, Long Day Care, Family Day Care and most Outside School Hours Care services are accredited. Kindergarten/pre-school care is not accredited. Home-based Carers and Occasional Care are not accredited services.

What questions should I ask?

NSW Department of Human Services - Community Services - and the National Childcare Accreditation Council give guidance to parents on choosing a service. You can visit their websites at:

- Is the service accredited? Ask to see the Certificate of Accreditation and Quality Profile.
- Do carers/staff speak with children in a warm and friendly way?
- What activities will my child be doing and how are they decided?
- What feedback will I be given about my child's day and how will this information be communicated?
- Is there a written program on display? How can my family be involved in the planning and evaluation of the program?
- What happens if my child requires medication? What if my child becomes sick or has an accident whilst in care?
- Do toys, equipment and activities available offer my child choice and meet his/her interest and abilities?
- Are the outdoor and indoor environments and equipment interesting, secure, safe and clean?

Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate

Child Care Benefit (CCB) and Child Care Rebate (CCR) help you with the cost of child care for Long Day Care, Family Day Care, Outside School Hours Care and Vacation Care.

ELIGIBILITY

You may qualify for CCB if:

- You use registered or approved child care. Families using registered care receive the minimum rate only.
- Your child is immunised (or on an immunisation catch up schedule), or is exempt from the immunisation requirements.
- You are responsible for paying the child care fees for your child.
- You and your child (or children) have legal resident status and reside in Australia on a permanent basis.

You may qualify for both CCB and CCR if:

- You use approved child care
- You meet all other requirements for CCB (as above)

CCB:

All eligible families can receive up to 24 hours of CCB for approved care per child per week. If you meet the work, training and study test, you may be eligible for up to 50 hours of CCB per week. To meet the test, you and your partner must undertake work or work-related activities such as training or studying for at least 15 hours per week. Please note that CCB is means tested.

CCR:

CCR is not means tested. It is a payment of up to 50% of the family's out of pocket expenses, after eligible CCB is deducted.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

You can choose to have your Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate paid directly to your approved child care service to reduce your child care fees, or you may claim it as a lump sum at the end of each financial year.

HOW TO CLAIM CCB AND CCR

You can claim Child Care Benefit by completing and lodging a claim form at any Family Assistance Office, located at **Centrelink Customer Service Centres** and **Medicare Australia** shopfronts or by visiting:

Priority of Access

In determining who is offered child care places, Warringah Council's Children's Services apply the Australian Government's Priority of Access Guidelines as follows:

- Priority 1** A child at risk of serious abuse or neglect.
- Priority 2** A child of a single parent who satisfies, or of parents who both satisfy the work/training/study test under Section 14 of the Family Assistance Act.
- Priority 3** Any other child.

Priorities within each category also apply as follows:

- Children in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families.
- Children in families which include a person with a disability.
- Children in families which include an individual whose adjusted taxable income does not exceed the lower income threshold under Clause 7, Schedule 2 of the Family Assistance Act, or who/whose partner is on income support.
- Children in families from a non-English speaking background.
- Children in socially isolated families.
- Children of single parents.

Council also gives priority to children with a sibling at the same centre, or with the same Family Day Care Educator.

If your family is eligible for a priority placement, please tick the relevant boxes on the Family Registration Form. Please note that you may be asked for supporting documentation prior to placement. You can obtain further information on the Priority of Access Guidelines by going to the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) website at **deewr.gov.au**.

Referral and Information Service

Council's aim is to assist families to access suitable childcare and other family services in Warringah. Information provided is comprehensive and updated regularly to ensure families receive accurate and helpful information on all local services.

Families registered are eligible to apply for placement at Council's Children's Services, including Long Day Care, Family Day Care and Occasional Care. **A registration form can be found in the back of this Directory and at Council's website at warringah.nsw.gov.au.**

Family registration does not guarantee placement at a service, but every effort will be made to provide suitable placement. Offers for placement at Long Day Care Centres to commence in January are made in October/November of the prior year. Vacancies may occur at any time however, and placement offers are made as vacancies arise.

Keeping information current gives families the best chance of placement. Please notify changes to circumstances as and when changes occur, including contact details, start date, or days of care required.

Family registration renewal occurs in March and September each year. At this time all families are contacted to update information and renew applications for care. Families who do not renew annual registration become inactive on the waitlist and are not considered for placement at a service.

The following advice is also provided to assist with placement of your child:

- Be flexible when nominating days and centres/services. Once your child is placed, you are in a position to take up extra days as they become available.
- When registering an additional child, avoid double file entries by advising us of your previous registration.
- Please do not contact the Long Day Care Centres or Family Day Care directly about placement until directed to do so.

Warringah Council Long Day Care

Warringah Council operates Four Long Day Care Centres. All centres are fully licensed under the NSW Children's Services Regulation 2004 and quality assured by the National Childcare Accreditation Council.

All centres operate to the highest standards and employ early childhood professional staff including teachers, trained educators and carers and operate Certified Preschool Programs (see p2). Staff to child ratios usually exceed the minimum requirements, with 1 carer for every 4 children established in the nurseries.

Centres provide:

- Nappies
- Cooked lunches
- Morning and afternoon tea

A full educational program is offered, with individual programs developed for each child from observations of their needs and interests. Children's experiences are enhanced to support learning in accordance with the NSW Children's Services Curriculum Framework and the Early Years Learning Framework. Successful transition to school is also supported through the development of confidence and social skills, together with school readiness programs.

Staff work respectfully with all families to ensure they can be involved and contribute to their child's positive experience of care. Centres welcome children from culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) backgrounds and children with additional needs, providing appropriate support and inclusion programs.

Warringah Council Family Day Care

Family Day Care is a licensed and accredited childcare service, funded by the Federal Government. Care is provided in the private homes of approved child Educators, caring for up to five children under school age at any one time (including their own children).

Family Day Care successfully offers professional and developmentally appropriate small group childcare in a family setting.

Family Day Care provides flexible care in accordance with family needs and includes full day care, part-time care, occasional and emergency care and in some instances before or after school care.

CHILD CARE EDUCATORS

Family Day Care Educators, their premises and the services offered must comply with the Children's Services Regulation 2004 and Children's Services Amended Regulation 2010. To ensure compliance:

- Educators and other household members undergo stringent selection procedures to assess their suitability to work with children, including interviews and probity checks (Working with Children Checks and reference checks).
- Premises are checked for compliance with regulatory health and safety requirements.
- A current first aid certificate is required along with participation in orientation and in-service training to ensure compliance with the regulation, policies and procedures and quality assured practices.
- Educators are visited on a regular basis and undergo regular auditing for compliance.

Educators must also participate in national accreditation of the Family Day Care scheme, requiring them to demonstrate continuous improvement and to participate in independent validation visits.

CHILD CARE PROGRAM

Educators offer personal programs, experiences and relationships to children appropriate to their individual needs. Educators are able to respond to each child's own interests and to use everyday events to provide developmentally appropriate learning experiences. Family Day Care learning practices align with current early childhood practices such as the Early Years Learning Framework. Educators are able to develop their programs through a partnership with their families and the support of early childhood professionals within the Coordination Unit, who also provide additional activities such as play sessions to enhance experiences for children.

COORDINATION OF CHILD CARE EDUCATORS

Family Day Care Educators are managed, trained, supervised and supported by a central coordination unit. Professionally qualified early childhood coordinators visit Educators in their homes on a regular basis to support Educators and monitor children. Coordinators assist Educators to develop early childhood and business practices to the highest standards through training, advice and policy development.

The coordination unit is also responsible for the enrolment and placement of children with Educators and for management of Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate payments on behalf of the Australian Government.

Warringah Council Occasional Care

Warringah Council's Occasional Care is a service designed to offer quality care for up to 20 children between 6 weeks and 6 years old. Some children attend part-time on a regular basis, whilst others are casual. The flexibility of the occasional care service allows parents to arrange care according to their differing needs.

A team of qualified and experienced staff members care for your child's needs. Ratios are 1:4 for 0-1 year olds, 1:5 for 2-3 year olds and 1:10 for 3-5 year olds. To ensure children are settled and enjoy their experience of care, the minimum staff to child ratios are often exceeded. A variety of interesting and stimulating experiences for children are provided each day, to ensure all children's needs are met, including those who attend regularly.

REGULAR BOOKINGS

Families may make a regular booking for care. Regular bookings are only available at the daily rate. Payments must be made in advance and there is no refund for absences. Please email the Service Director at brookvalechildrenscentre@warringah.nsw.gov.au.

CASUAL BOOKINGS

Bookings may be made for casual care up to one week in advance. No guarantee of placement can be given for casual users who have not booked in advance. Children new to the service may need a settling in period.

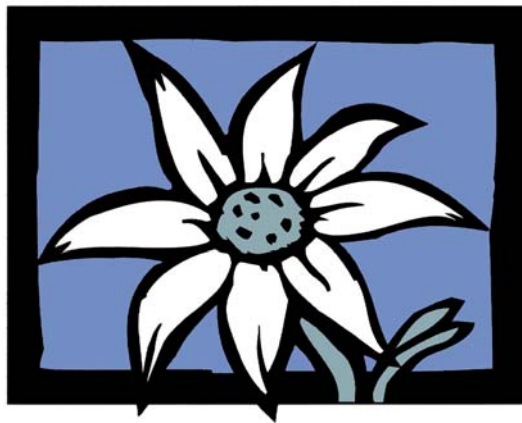
